RESOLUTION NO. 88

“WHEREAS, The City Government of Bayawan has efforts to promote Local Culture and Tourism and mold the youth in a holistic and integrative manner, which include honing their talents to perform in the arts and express their thought through speech;

“WHEREAS, The Miss Bayawan Beauty Pageant has been part of the annual celebration of the City as part of the Tawo-Tawo Festival every February;

“WHEREAS, in collaboration with the City Tourism Office and the Technical Working Group tasked for the holding of Miss Bayawan 2024 composed of Dr. Anelito A. Bongcawil, Schools Division Superintendent, Ms. Christine Lorraine T. Tijing, Public Schools District Supervisor, Mr. Arlan T. Entac, Administrative Officer V, Mr. Atilano Jude S. Cabangal, Supervising Administrative Officer, Mr. Donald P. Tubio, City Accountant, Mrs. Emma H. Artes, Education Program Supervisor for English and Mr. Christopher U. Bantog, Education Program Supervisor for Araling Panlipunan, exchange views and ideas in the amendment/formulation of the Miss Bayawan Ordinance

“WHEREAS, in the pursuit of excellence the City needs to level-up guidelines for the pageant;

“WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Councilor Mark Fidencio L. Aurelia and duly seconded by Honorable Councilor Rolando B. Abrasaldo, the Council

“RESOLVED, To enact, as it hereby enacts the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 1

THE MISS BAYAWAN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained that:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance shall be known as “The Miss Bayawan Ordinance”

SECTION 2. The Miss Bayawan Beauty Pageant is hereby made as the official event and highlight of the Tawo-Tawo Festival Season, every February.

SECTION 3. STATEMENT OF THE PURPOSE: The Miss Bayawan Beauty Pageant is the annual search for the Lady who possesses the essence of a Bayawanon. This is the platform that showcases beauty, femininity, character, values, talent and intellect.

SECTION 4. QUALIFICATIONS. The following set of requisites and qualifications is hereby adopted as the basic standards that shall be used in the search and selection of Miss Bayawan, viz:

- 1.1 Single, Female at birth, and 18 to 24 years old
- 1.2 Without biological child
- 1.3 Pleasing Personality and Good Moral Character including those with exceptionalities
- 1.4 Filipino, a bonafide resident of Bayawan for at least Six (6) months or with family roots in Bayawan as certified by the Punong Barangay
- 1.5 Willing to represent the City of Bayawan on certain functions requiring her presence as prescribed through a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)

SECTION 5. THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. There shall be an Executive Committee who will spearhead and supervise the operations of Miss Bayawan. The committee shall be composed of the identified officers/members from the National Government Agencies, Civil Society Organizations and the like as stipulated by a Memorandum of Agreement with the City Government of Bayawan.

SECTION 6. POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. The Committee reserves the right to make changes to the program during the competition. The final version of the holding and filling of the pageant and part of the program approved in the process of preparation for the competition.

They have the exclusive rights to photograph, video, film and print materials in the preparation and conduct of the pageant.

SECTION 7. GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION.

The Executive Committee reserves the right to exclude from the list of qualified candidates:

- 7.1 Who provides false information (or did not provide additional information and documents for their confirmation);
- 7.2 Who refuses to perform the competition activities; and
- 7.3 Who violates the rules and regulations of the competition.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The committee shall have the authority to come up with the Implementing Rules and Regulations.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or illegal by a competent court, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations inconsistent herewith are likewise repealed and amended accordingly.

SECTION 11. This Ordinance shall take effect after compliance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.


