RESOLUTION NO. 22

"WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 34, series of 2002, enacted under Resolution No. 637 s. 2002, "An ordinance implementing Section 1.206, Division 2, of P.D. 1185, otherwise known as the Fire Code of the Philippines" was returned by the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Negros Oriental with the advice that same shall be re-enacted for reasons that the public hearing was conducted after it was enacted.

"WHEREAS, considering that the ordinance has gone through all the process in its enactment except that the public hearing was conducted after its enactment and considering also the need to impose the Fire Inspection Fee as provided in the Fire Code of the Philippines, there is a need to re-enact the foregoing ordinance.

"WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Councilor Barte and duly seconded by Honorable Councilor Dael, the Council

"RESOLVED, to re-enact, as it hereby re-enacts the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING SECTION 1.206,  
DIVISION 2, OF P.D. 1185, OTHERWISE KNOWN  
AS THE FIRE CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES.

Be it ordained that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby imposed a fire inspection fee which shall be collected on all buildings that require permit or licenses from the City Engineer or Building Officer, as the case may be, with special emphasis on commercial buildings as required by P.D. 1185, the Fire Code of the Philippines, specifically, Div. 2, Sec. 1.206.

SECTION 2. The Fire Safety Inspection Certificate shall be issued by the City Fire Marshal upon payment by the applicant to the Office of the City Treasurer of the amount equivalent to 10% of all fees charged by the Building Officer or by other government agency concerned in the granting of pertinent permits and/or licenses.



SECTION 3. The fees and fines as provided in Section 2 hereof shall be remitted by the City Treasurer to the National Treasury.

SECTION 4. Any person found violating the provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in the amount not exceeding FIVE THOUSAND PESOS ((5,000.00) or an imprisonment of not exceeding One (1) year, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court. In case of a corporation, firm, partnership or cooperative, the person in charge shall be held liable for such fine and imprisonment; Provided that where the violation has caused the loss of lives and/or damage to property the violator shall be proceeded against the applicable provision of the Revised Penal Code.

SECTION 5. Provisions of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.


SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect after compliance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, R.A. 7160.




