RESOLUTION ENACTING ORDINANCE NO. 59, CURRENT SERIES, AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 12199 IN THE CITY OF BAYAWAN OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT (ECCD) SYSTEM ACT" DEFINING ITS POWERS AND FUNCTIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

"WHEREAS, Article II, Section 13 of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being;

"WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 12199, also known as AN ACT FURTHER STRENGTHENING THE EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT SYSTEM, REPEALING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10410, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "EARLY YEARS ACT (EYA) ACT OF 2013", AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

"WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers local government units to promote the general welfare and provide basic services, including programs and child welfare and development;

"WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Bayawan to ensure that children in their formative years are provided with holistic, appropriate, and accessible early childhood care and development programs;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Councilor Efleda A. Renacia and duly seconded by Honorable Councilor Sharlou F. Jamin, the Council

RESOLVED, To enact, as it hereby enacts the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 12199 IN THE CITY OF BAYAWAN OTHERWISE KNOWN AS “EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT (ECCD) SYSTEM ACT” DEFINING ITS POWERS AND FUNCTIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it ordained that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – Adoption of RA 12199 IN THE CITY OF BAYAWAN OTHERWISE KNOWN AS “EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT (ECCD) SYSTEM ACT.”

SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF ECCD PROGRAMS.

The City of Bayawan shall establish and strengthen Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) programs in accordance with the standards set by RA 12199 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

SECTION 3. LOCAL ECCD COUNCIL / COMMITTEE.

A Local ECCD Council or Committee is hereby constituted to oversee the implementation of ECCD programs, in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd), City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO), and the Early Childhood Care and Development Council.

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS.

Funds necessary for the effective implementation of this Ordinance shall be sourced from the City of Bayawan budget and other possible funding sources, subject to availability of funds and applicable accounting and auditing rules.

SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES.

The Office of the Mayor in coordination with concerned offices, shall issue local implementing guidelines to ensure effective enforcement of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If for any purpose, any part or provision of this ordinance, proclamations, memorandum, executive and administrative orders shall be held unconstitutional, invalid or illegal, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All ordinances, resolutions, and issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and compliance with the posting and publication requirements under RA 7160, the Local Government Code.





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
