RESOLUTION NO. 24

“Presented for consideration Resolution No. 962, of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Oriental Negros, returning to this body Resolution No. 471, series of 2005, enacting Ordinance No. 37, “An Ordinance Prohibiting the Forced Intake of Liquid/Solid on Livestock within the City of Bayawan” for modification, inviting attention to the recommendation of the Provincial Attorney embodied in his 2<sup>nd</sup> endorsement dated September 22, 2005 which states “that since the prohibition only applies to persons who are engaged in the business of buying and selling livestock, the same applies only to certain class of persons. The prohibition should apply to every person, whether he is engaged in the business of buying and selling of livestock or not, as the prohibited act for instance, could be committed by an owner of an animal before being sold to a party who is engaged in the buying and selling of livestock.

“WHEREAS, the body deemed it proper to revise the foregoing ordinance in accordance with the comments of the Provincial Attorney contained in his 2<sup>nd</sup> endorsement dated September 22, 2005.

“WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Councilor Raymond and duly seconded by Honorable Oscar T. Villamil, President of the LNMB, the Council

“RESOLVED, To enact as it hereby enacts the following ordinance, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 4

REVISED ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE FORCED INTAKE OF LIQUID/SOLID ON LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE CITY OF BAYAWAN, ORIENTAL NEGROS.”

Be it ordained that:

SECTION 1. Definition of Terms.

- a) Forced intake - Means forcibly putting something in a form of liquid/solid on livestock which is beyond the capacity of the animal for the purpose of increasing its weight for profit/gain.
- b) Livestock - Domestic animals, as cattle and hogs, bred or kept on a farm for use and commercial profit..

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to forcibly put excessive liquid/solid in any manner into the livestock within the city whether for sale or transport.

SECTION 3. Penalty Clause. Any person or group of persons found violating this ordinance shall be punished by an imprisonment of one (1) year or a fine of Five Thousand Pesos PHP5,000.00 or both at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 4. Repealing Clause. This ordinance supercedes Resolution No. 417, enacting Ordinance No. 37, series of 2005.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after compliance with the provisions of R. A. 7160, the LGC of 1991.
