RESOLUTION NO. 67

“WHEREAS, Section 16 of general welfare clause of RA 7160 provides in part that every local government unit shall exercise powers necessary for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essentials to the promotion of general welfare;

“WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 688, Declaring the period of year 2013-2022 as the Philippines decade of “Make the Right Real” for Persons With Disabilities in support of the 3rd Asian and Pacific Decade of Persons With Disabilities also known as the “Incheon Strategy” which recommended to build on the gains towards disability inclusive development in translation of the objectives of BP 344, RA Nos. 7277,9442, 10070, 10524 and other disability related laws, programs, activities, projects and policies in which all departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the national government and local government units in consultation with the private sector, civil society organizations, non-government organizations and people with disability organizations are directed to implement.

“WHEREAS, the Bayawan Federation of Persons With Disabilities (BFPWD) is an organized group of Persons With Disability (PWD’s) which is under the supervisory of the City Social Welfare and Development Office, duly accredited to the City Government of Bayawan dated August 29, 2013 and registered to DSWD with registration No. FO VII 259 dated December 4, 2007 issued at DSWD FO VII Cebu City, Philippines.

“WHEREAS, the activities of organization initiated and headed by the Chapter Presidents to mark the program of the milestone achieved for this marginalized sector will focus on encouraging the persons with disability sector in taking pro-active roles in nation building.

“NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Councilor Jamin and duly seconded by Honorable Councilor Sumalpong, the Council

“RESOLVED, To enact, as it hereby enacts the following ordinance:



ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING BAYAWAN FEDERATION OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES AND PROVIDING MONTHLY CASH ASSISTANCE TO EVERY CHAPTER PRESIDENTS THEREOF

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panglungsod of the City of Bayawan in session assembled, that:

Section 1. Title: this ordinance shall be known as AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING BAYAWAN FEDERATION OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES AND PROVIDING MONTHLY CASH ASSISTANCE TO EVERY CHAPTER PRESIDENTS THEREOF

Section 2. BFPWD Chapter Presidents – are those legally identified PWD's duly elected/appointed and certified by the BFPWD.

2.1 Functions, Duties and Responsibilities.

- Attend and submit report in every BFPWD regular meetings and participate in other programs projects and activities as necessary and or required by the federation.
- Conduct regular PWD meetings in respective Barangays/area of jurisdiction.
- Initiate, coordinate and monitor the implementation of plans, programs, projects and polices related to PWD's.
- Create linkages and seek funds for the benefit of PWD chapter associations, BFPWD and the whole sector.
- Abide the constitution and bylaws of the BFPWD
- Do other tasks assigned by the federation.

2.2 Organizational Structure.

- BFPWD is composed of 32 Chapter Presidents.
- The 32 Chapter Presidents are automatically members of the Board of Directors (BOD).
- Among the BOD the officers shall be elected from.

2.3 Classifications and Numbers of Chapters.

- a. Urban Barangays – 8 Chapters
- b. Rural Barangays – 24 Chapters

Section 3. Funds

- 3.1 Amount allocation: Php336,000.00 annually
- 3.2 Purpose of Allocating Funds: the amount in the form of monthly cash assistance for BFPWD Chapter Presidents shall be utilized to defray PWD related activities as to their functions, duties and responsibilities.
- 3.3 Source of Funds. As per approved SP Resolution no. 306 dated April 21, 2015 relative to the BFPWD Resolution no. 06 series of 2015, the same amount appropriated from the budget allocated to CSWD charged to Elderly Persons With Disability Program in which GAA Sec. 29 stated that the least one percent of all

government agency budget shall be allocated to elderly and PWD related programs, projects and activities.

3.4 Amount allocation category.

- a. Urban Barangays: Php500.00/chapter president / month
 - 8 Chapter Presidents x Php500.00 x 12 months = Php48,000.00 annually.
- b. Rural Barangays: Php1,000.00/chapter president/month
 - 24 Chapter President x Php1,000.00 x 12 months = Php288,000.00 annually

3.5 Breakdown:

Urban Barangay	8	Php48,000.00
Rural Barangay	24	Php288,000.00
Total:	32	Php366,000.00

Section 4. Repealing Clause: All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, which provisions are in conflict with, or contrary to the provisions of the ordinance³ are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.


Section 5. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval thereof in accordance with the law.




